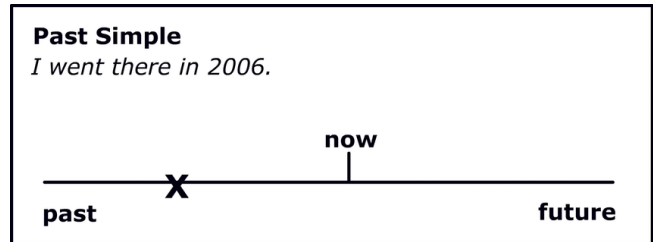

Past simple

- ★ Se usa para hablar de acciones completas en el pasado.



Para formar oraciones, se usa la siguiente estructura:

- ✓ Oraciones afirmativas:

<p>I He She It You We They</p>	}	verb in past + complement
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Examples:

They **ran** in the park last Sunday.
(Ellos **corrieron** en el parque el domingo pasado)



The kids **saw** a giraffe at the zoo.
(Los niños **vieron** una jirafa en el zoológico)

I **went** to a café with my mom.
(**Fui** a una cafetería con mi mamá)



✓ Oraciones negativas:

Examples:

I **didn't take** photos of my trip.
(No **tome** fotos de mi viaje)



She **didn't have** pizza. She had a hamburger.
(Ella **no comió** pizza. Comió una hamburguesa)

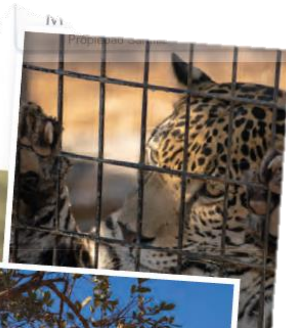
