

Past simple

★ Se usa para hablar de acciones completas en el pasado.



Para formar oraciones, se usa la siguiente estructura:

✓ Oraciones afirmativas:



Examples:

They ran in the park last Sunday.

(Ellos corrieron en el parque el domingo pasado)





The kids **saw** a giraffe at the zoo.

(Los niños vieron una jirafa en el zoológico)

I went to a café with my mom.

(Fui a una cafetería con mi mamá)



✓ Oraciones negativas:



Examples:

I didn't take photos of my trip.

(No tome fotos de mi viaje)





She **didn't have** pizza. She had a hamburger. (Ella no comió pizza. Comió una hamburguesa)

Part 2

✓ Oraciones interrogativas y respuestas cortas:

Short answers:



No, (subject) didn't.

Examples:



Did you **buy** a new book? (¿Compro un libro?) Yes, I did.





Did he do the homework? (¿Nizo la tarea?)
No, he didn't.

Regular and Irregular verbs


Regular verbs	Irregular verbs	
Cuando se conjugan en pasado, a los verbos regulares se le agrega el sufijo -ed o -d.	La conjugación de los verbos irregulares cambia, ya que estos no terminan en -ed o -d, sino que la palabra completa se modifica. Es necesario memorizar la conjugación.	
Example: Dance - Danced Play - Played Love - Loved Walk - Walked	Examples: Do - Did Buy – Bought See – Saw Be – Was/Were


